

My Essential Coloured Pencils

It's very easy to become overwhelmed when it comes to knowing the best pencils to buy when you're first starting out, so I have listed what I feel are essentials for animal portraits.

Artist quality coloured pencils can be an expensive investment, however, using quality pencils does make a difference. Buying the pencils singly means you don't have to pay a huge amount for a whole set - you may wish to do that at some point, but this shortlist will give you a really good start, these are the ones I use in almost every drawing.

I've included four of my favourite pencil brands. Polychromos are oil-based, hard, great for details, blending and just a good all-round pencil. Pablos are great for smoothing and have some super colours, Luminance are expensive but amazing for blending and adding those little touches of colour, and the Drawing is a big fat wax pencil - the blackest black and fab for covering large areas.
